



Welcome to Year 5!

Your child's new class teacher in September will be Miss Antoinette.

Your child's class will be called Bevan and will be in Sharman's old room.

Drop off will be in the Year 2 Playground and collection will be from the Main Playground.

At the beginning of the day all children will enter through the lower Trinity Street gate, parents can walk them round to their classroom if they want to.

The lower Trinity Street gate will be open from 8.45—9.00am each morning (children will be marked late if they arrive after 9.00am). From 8.45am the children will be walking straight into class, support staff will be available in the playground to encourage them in.

At the end of the day the lower Trinity Street gate will be open from 3.00—3.20pm (at which point it will be locked) with the children being dismissed from 3.15pm. Anyone arriving after 3.25pm will need to wait until the top gate is clear to be able to collect their child.

Please ensure that you follow the one way system at all times and check the attached map for the start and end of the day locations.

Please remember that your child must wear school uniform every day (and school colours must be stuck to). Chase Side has a no-brands policy. Children should wear black school shoes or white/black sandals, Boots or trainers are not allowed as everyday footwear. Please see the attached sheet for more details.

Please remember also that jewellery cannot be worn for school. Children are only allowed to wear stud earrings, but these must be removed at home on PE days. If you are planning to have your child's ears pierced, please do this at the beginning of the long summer holiday so that they have a chance to heal and can be removed easily when necessary.

The children all eat in the Dining Hall together. For packed lunch children please provide a healthy lunch (sweets, chocolate bars, chocolate biscuits and fizzy drinks are NOT permitted). For all children, Friday is "treat day" where children are allowed one treat with their packed lunch as the school dinner children also have a treat. **We are a nut free school, (which includes any chocolate based spread), as we have children and staff on site with severe allergies.**

The children can have a healthy snack, **this is a piece of fruit** (provided for children from Nursery to Year 2), we eat this in the classroom after break as part of our Zone of Regulation well being routine.

At lunch the children are given 20 minutes uninterrupted time to eat and then 30 minutes outside to play. We will give you more details that are relevant to your class at the 'Meet the Team Meeting' in September.
