The School:

We will...

- Provide a safe environment at school where everyone is valued and respected.

- Develop the whole child, nurture the well-being of each child so they can achieve their best and contribute positively to their learning.
- Let parents know of concerns or problems that may affect their child's learning including behaviour, attendance or punctuality.
- Do our utmost to ensure children do not have access to any inappropriate material on the internet.

The Family:

We will...

- Ensure my child is well prepared and equipped for school each day including correct uniform, PE kit, reading book, book bag and home learning.
- Support our school in promoting healthy lifestyles e.g. by providing healthy lunches for my child.
- Take responsibility for our child attending school each day, arriving and being collected on time unless they are ill or have absence authorised. We will also inform the school and follow procedures regarding absence.
- Provide correct and up-to-date contact details.
Support our child's learning at home through reading, other home learning provided and other learning opportunities.
- Attend consultation evenings, discussions and other meetings about my child's progress or learning including any outside agency appointments.
- Support the school's policies including behaviour and uniform policies.
- Promote a positive relationship between home and school, behaving in a respectful manner to staff and other parents and children.

The Child:

We will...

- Attend school each day and on time, arriving in a calm and respectful manner.
- Wear the correct school uniform and PE kit. Be organised for the school day and have the right tools for the job.
- Participate fully in school life and be a good ambassador for the school in all situations.
- Do all my class work and home learning as well as I can, ensuring I do my best and submit it on time.
- Be polite and helpful to others, taking responsibility for my own behaviour; both my actions and words. Respect and value all staff and children in the school, demonstrating a sense of responsibility and a caring approach towards others.
- Follow our school policies including moving around the school in a sensible and safe manner.
- Let an adult know if I need help, am unhappy about anything or see something dangerous or unsafe.
