<p><b>English:</b> Write a play script for part of the Willow Pattern Poem.</p>	<p><b>PSHCE:</b> Write a plan for effective tooth care, including how to brush effectively and which foods to avoid/eat etc.</p>	<p><b>History:</b> Imagine you're a child from the Tudor or Victorian era. Create a postcard that shows a typical activity like playing or helping at home. On the other side, write a short message about your daily life and it's challenges.</p>	<p><b>PSHCE/Geography:</b> Interview someone you know who has lived in another country. Ask them about what life is like in that country and how they came to live in the UK.</p>
<p><b>Music:</b> Find out about the origins of the Ukulele or another string instrument. Present your findings to the class in a format of your choice.</p>	<p><b>English/Art:</b> Design a front cover based on the Willow Pattern Poem.</p>	<p><b>Science:</b> Place ice cubes in different parts of your home and see how quickly they melt. Write up a conclusion your findings.</p>	<p><b>English/Maths:</b> The answer is 64, what is the question?  What questions can you write that would give you this answer? Be creative</p>
<p><b>British Sign language:</b> Learn the signs for all 26 letters of the alphabet.</p>	<p><b>RE:</b> Search the internet for Hindu Mandala art. Can you design your own mandala using inspiration from your web search?</p>	<p><b>PE:</b> Link 5 dance moves together to create a dance to perform in front of the class.</p>	<p><b>ICT:</b> Design an e-safety poster. Include tips for staying safe on the internet and consider how much time you think is suitable for children to spend playing computer games.</p>
