Would you recommend it? Why? COMPUTING/ENGLISH	Create your own classification tree for any topic of your choice. SCIENCE
Hot	Write about the importance of classification. Include as much detail as possible. You could even turn it into a PowerPoint. SCIENCE	Research The Alps and create a fact file on them. GEOGRAPHY	Create a fun way of teaching how percentages, fractions and decimals are similar. E.g. 50% is $\frac{1}{2}$ or 0.5 MATHS	Design a poster on e-safety and/ or internet safety..

RE	Make a poster to explain as many different word classes as you can such as: Verb, noun, adverb, preposition, pronoun, conjunction. SPaG	Create a sequence of stretches for our gymnastic warm up session.	Make a list of modal verbs and use them in sentences. E.g., might- I might be going to the cinema tomorrow. SPaG
Extra Mild	Write about an area of maths you found challenging but have now mastered and explain how you did it. MATHS	Create a comic strip to illustrate an electrical system in action. DT	Create a poster about the significant person your class is named after for display.
