Extra Hot	MATHS and D&T: Design a game to help us to learn our times tables and division facts.	SCIENCE: Draw a poster of the digestive system, showing what each organ does. You could include what foods to eat to keep your teeth healthy and strong.
Hot	ENGLISH: Write up a conversation between you and a family member. Remember the rules for dialogue - new speaker = new line, capital letter, other punctuation INSIDE the inverted commas.	GEOGRAPHY: Have a go at making your own volcano at home. https://www.nhm.ac.uk/discover/how-to-make-a-volcano.html	MATHS: Look around your home and in nature for patterns. Write/draw what you see and what you notice about these patterns.	ENGLISH: Write a persuasive letter to your teacher on why you should or shouldn't be able to choose your own seating within the class.
