Extra Hot	Can you make up your own story about a pet of your own? Can you turn it into a little book like <i>Hairy McClary</i> by the author Lynley Dodd?	Practise your number bond (pairs) for numbers up to 20. Don't forget to practise pairs to 12, 15, and 17 etc	What things do we need to do to keep healthy? Create a poster all about keeping healthy.
Hot	Can you find a non-fiction book about pets? Can you draw a picture of your favourite pet and write down three facts you have found out about them? 	Choose a number between 0 and 20 and write a, I'm thinking about, riddle e.g., a number that is even and comes before number 9.	Materials- can you look around the house and see if you can find bags made of different materials. How many different kinds can you find? Plastic, fabric, paper etc. Draw a picture and label them or take a photo.
Mild	Can you make a rhyming description of an animal like Lynley Dodd? Draw a picture and write the description. Such as <i>Bottomly Potts</i> all covered in spots.
