Extra Hot	Can you find out about an explorer? What was their name? When did they live? What made them an explorer? Make a poster or an information sheet about them.	Practise your number bond (pairs) for numbers up to 100. Don't forget to practise pairs to use your related facts.	What things do we need to do to keep healthy? Create a poster all about keeping healthy.
Hot	Materials - make a list of the different materials you can see in your home. You could draw some of the items and label them.	Choose a number between 0 and 20 and write a, I'm thinking about, riddle e.g. a number that is even and comes before number 9.	We are using different shapes and sizes of paper to make structures. What can you make out of paper?
Mild	Find out about who your class is named after. Draw a picture and write at least 3 facts about them. Annie Maunder (Russell), astronomer	Measure your height and list objects and people that are taller or shorter than you.	In RE we are looking at Christianity and what Jesus means to Christians families. What important person means a lot in your family? Write a small paragraph about the person.
Extra Mild	Write a list. This could be a shopping list or a to-do list. Use your sounds to help you write words you are not sure how to spell.	Make your own number line to 20.
