Would you recommend it? Why? COMPUTING/ENGLISH	Create a 3D model to demonstrate how the heart works. SCIENCE
Hot	Write about what William Harvey found out about the circulatory system. Include as much detail as possible. You could even turn it into a PowerPoint. SCIENCE	Research a desert and create a fact file on it. GEOGRAPHY	Create a fun way of teaching how percentages, fractions and decimals are similar. E.g. 50% is $\frac{1}{2}$ or 0.5 MATHS	Create a guide on how to read Roman numerals. MATHS
Mild	Research the different types of architecture used in the different religious holy places. RE	Make a poster to explain as many different word classes as you can such as: Verb, noun, adverb, preposition, pronoun, conjunction. SPaG	Draw and label the heart. SCIENCE	Make a list of modal verbs and use them in sentences. E.g., might- I might be going to the cinema tomorrow. SPaG
Extra Mild	Write about an area of maths you found challenging but have now mastered and explain how you did it. MATHS	Create a comic strip to illustrate how to make a pop-up toy. DT	Create a poster explaining how to stay safe when using glue guns and saws, consider the dangers. DT	Create a poster to inform the class about a community that you are part of - it could be a club, faith, neighbourhood, country etc. PSHE
