Can you invent a new space story? Who would go to space; or who would visit Earth from space? Write and illustrate a short story including your new character.	Create a fact file about an animal you like. Where does it live? What does it eat? Add any other fascinating facts!	Make up some number stories based on adding and subtracting numbers to 20. You could add sweets together, take away fruit from the fruit bowl or come up with any other ideas that you can!
Can you find out some facts about space? Name the planets in our solar system. Create a piece of art work based on space.	Can you find and label items in your home that are made from wood plastic and metal? Which material did you find most of?	Can you create a poster to encourage others to recycle? Which materials can be recycled? Where can you recycle these items?
Learn how to spell the days of the week. Don't forget they must begin with a capital letter.	Can you make a poster to help people learn their number bonds to 10 or 20? E.g. $2 + 8 = 10$ so $12 + 8 = 20$.	Can you make a healthy snack for your family to share - remember to ask an adult to help you! Can you draw a picture and list the ingredients.
Tell your family your favourite story. Remember to make it interesting and speak clearly. We would love it if you shared it with the class too!	Can you count in 2s by reading the house numbers in your road? Is it different on the other side of the road?	Make up a simple sequence of travelling and balancing movements to teach the rest of the class in the PE lesson.
