How can you compare these two different wooded environments?</p>	<p>Make your own dictionary on a theme of your choice e.g. rocks dictionary, The human body, Ancient Rome, Rainforests. Focus on key topic words and the meaning. Remember the layout of a dictionary – alphabetical order.</p>	<p>Create a multiple-choice quiz on any topic we have studied this year, for someone to answer during home learning time.</p>
<p>Recreate a scene by drawing using mixed media (pencils, felt tips, crayons or charcoal). This could be of a famous castle within the UK <i>(Display)</i></p>	<p>Design an alternative front cover for our text 'Stitch Head' by Guy Bass. Write a blurb to go with your front cover.</p>	<p>Write about a religious festival that may be important to you or somebody you know.</p>	<p>Research a castle from within the UK. Include facts about where it is, who built it and what has happened throughout some of its history.</p>
<p>Create images/drawings to display different fractions of amounts.</p>	<p>Explain why eggs are a symbol of Easter. Can you design and decorate your own egg?</p>	<p>Create a piece of artwork based upon light and shadow. This will link to our topic in Science.</p>	<p>Create a poster to promote your favourite book for Book Week. You can include your favourite parts and/ or illustrations.</p>
<p>Write and recite a limerick on any topic that we have covered in Year 3 so far or one of your own choice (eg. magnets, rocks, pirates, bees).</p>	<p>Take part in a cooking activity with an adult and measure the ingredients in grams and millilitres.</p>	<p>Plan your own warm up for a lesson in PE to teach to the rest of the class. You may want to include music to make it more fun!</p>	<p>Write a review of a piece art that you like. Why do you like it? What technique does the artist use? How does it make you feel?</p>
