 The **Challenge-o-meter** suggests the difficulty or challenge the home learning may offer. Every term you should attempt at least one **'EXTRA HOT'** task!

Create your own story. Make sure you describe the characters and the setting.	Design a leaflet explaining what plants need to stay healthy.	Draw a picture of your favourite toy. What is similar and what is different from toys 100 years ago? For example, Lego, teddies or doll houses.	At home, follow a recipe to make a cake or anything else with an adult. Make sure you measure your ingredients carefully.
Research the sacred books used in Christianity, Islam, and Judaism. What is similar and what is different?	Can you find half, a third and a quarter of a shape or a number?	Be an artist. Sketch the spring/summer landscape.	Discuss what material things are made of and why. For example: A window is made of glass, so it is clear and lets light through.
Write some questions using the 5Ws: Who, What, Where, When and Why.	Write a book review for your favourite fairy tale.	Recall your 2, 5 and 10 times table. Can you find the related division facts?	Draw different types of weather (sunny, cloudy rain, snow) write a caption for your pictures.
Write your number in words to 20.	Read your favourite book and retell it in your own words.	Can you count backwards from 100?	Share your favourite song from music with your family.
