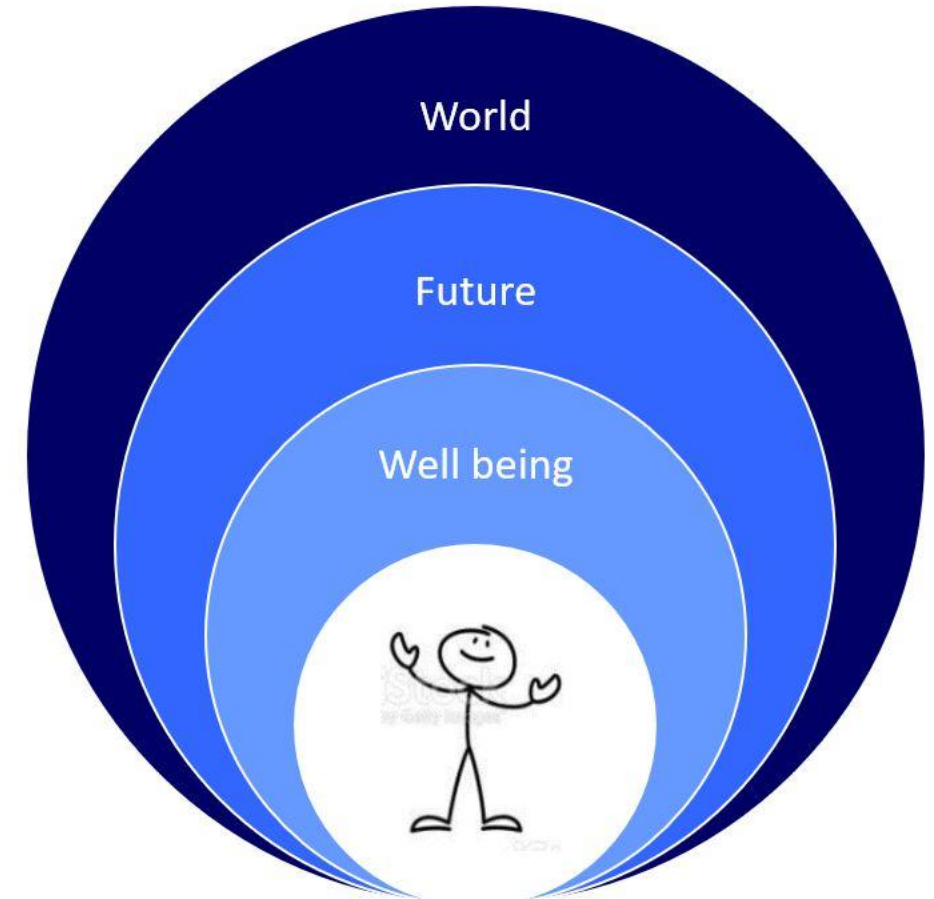

A little bit about our topics of study this year...



- The Year 6 curriculum will build upon all that children have learnt in primary school thus far and will prepare them ready for secondary school.
- We work hard to create meaningful links across the subjects.
- In **English** we use high quality books and short films to inspire our writing.
- In **Mathematics** we use a range of practical methods and formal written methods to solve problems.

Our typical day

- Every day will contain:

Arithmetic, Maths, English, Reading, SPaG and then a topic lesson in the afternoon.

PE Days



On PE days children come to school in their active uniform (their PE kit).

Class emails

- This year, we are moving away from class emails. Any emails about sickness or pick ups must go to the office, they will pass the information onto us in the classroom.
- At the start of every term, an email will be sent out about what to expect throughout term via the school office.
- Please check that we have the correct email address for you on the list to ensure you receive all important information.

Home Learning



Spelling Shed is our way for the children to access spellings at home. We will begin to set weekly spellings in preparation for SATs. We will go through the new spellings each Thursday and have a test of the previous week's spellings.

There are a range of games children can play to practise their spellings – you may need the sound up for some of them so they can hear the sound or word they are looking for.

‘Take away’ Home learning – this will be a grid with a range of different activities your child can try at home linked to the learning each term. It will be uploaded to the website next week. Please either email or send in any home learning so we can celebrate it in school.

Healthy School



- Remember we are a healthy school.
- This means that we ask the children to access WATER during the day, not juice/squash.
- We have fruit provided as part of the Healthy School initiative, which the children all have access to.
- We are a NUT FREE school, with some severe allergies, please do not give your child any nut products in their lunches.

This includes Nutella and Peanut Butter!

Birthdays



- We are unable to accept sweets/cakes etc for the children for birthdays or other occasions. If you wish to provide something for the class to enjoy, a wet play game or story book is very appreciated.
- We do not hand out party invitations at school, this will need to be organised outside of school.

Medicines

- Please ensure that your child's medication is in school and within date.
- We must have the completed care plan otherwise we are unable to administer any medicine.
- Do not place medicine or creams in your child's bag – please give them to a member of staff.
- If your child has been in hospital, please make one of us aware, as we may need to make a short term care plan to ensure we are able to care for them effectively.

Attendance

- We expect all children to attend school every day. Please make every effort to ensure your child attends on time every day.
- The doors are open at 8:45 and close at 9:00 prompt, if you arrive after this time your child will need to enter via the front gate and office.
- If your child has sickness or diarrhoea due to a bug please keep them off for 48 hours after the last bout.
