ENGLISH – Inspired by the story, 'George's Marvellous Medicine' can you create a recipe for your own magical potion? Aim to include the benefits and any possible side-effects of the mixture.	SCIENCE – Create a fact file on different types of the solids, liquids and gases around us. You could also include drawings.	MATHS - Create a maths board game based on the place value and number learning from the term.
Hot	RE - Create an information poster about Hinduism. Include important people, buildings and celebrations too.	PSHE - Create a poster informing our class of rules and routines in Year 3.	SCIENCE - Research a scientist of your choice. Create and present a PowerPoint presentation to show your findings (can be emailed to share in class).	ENGLISH – Choose an everyday object and aim to write a paragraph that informs your reader, how the object works. Eg. a blender, toaster or a vegetable peeler
Mild	SCIENCE – find and describe different types liquids, solids and gases. You could take photographs or try sketching them and how they appear different from each other.	MATHS - Practise addition and subtraction within 50. Can you write the inverse number sentence? e.g. $20 + 15 = 35$ $35 - 15 = 20$	READING/ART - Can you illustrate your favourite scene from the book you are reading? Write a caption to go with it.	ICT - Design an e-safety poster. Include tips for staying safe on the internet and consider how much time you think is suitable for children to spend playing computer games.
Extra Mild	HISTORY – Research how children's lives have changed since the Tudor and Victorian times. List five interesting facts and present these to your class.	D&T – Build a small 3D model of your house or a small building using paper and cardboard	MATHS - Create your own times table song/rap.
