This week has been another busy testing week, Year 4 have now completed their online Multiplications Test, Year 2 are half way through their SATs test and Year 1 / 2 have been completing their Phonics Screen checks. As always, we are proud of all of your children and know that they have tried their hardest with whatever work we have put in front of them.

Next week is Sports Week (check your individual class emails for more specific information for your child), as it will be an active week, (if possible) your child can wear **PE kit (school colours, no football kits)** everyday if they want to. We have a range of new activities at school for the children to try taster sessions and we also have the big Sports Day event (weather permitting) on Wednesday 17th June, Key Stage 2 9.30am at Holtwhites and Key Stage 1 1.45pm on site. Reception and Nursery will be having their Sports Day activities on Tuesday 16th June (please check your class-based emails for more details). If you are going to Holtwhites, they very kindly let us have this space so that parents can attend – do not walk across the cricket pitches (these will be marked out by cones).

Today we sent the link to book time slots for the final parent's consultation of the year (24th and 25th June unless specifically changed due to staff availability), you have until 22nd June to book an appointment.

Our Summer Fair is Saturday 4th July, each class has its own stall to organise, please see your class teachers to volunteer for a short session supporting your classes stall (let's see which stalls have the most support). Please find attached the Fair details and a reminder for Rainbow Day. Also thank you for the Happy Bag donations we have raised over £70, next time there will be no bags so you will be able to bring any donations in black bin bags.

We have a number of children on the timber trail, Y2 climbing frame and hanging from the Reception hand rail after we have dismissed them, please remember that these pieces of equipment are designed for specific age groups, we train the children how to use them and they should not be being used after school (there are signs up that say this).

In the last few weeks, we have had visitors to the school make comments about the children they can see in the corridor so we are going to be adding frosted covering to the door leading into the building to protect their privacy. Also, we have been having issues with children damaging the KS2 toilets, after a discussion with the Governors we have decided to add CCTV cameras to the lobby outside of the toilets so that we can monitor which children are going in and out of the toilets at the times that the damage is being caused.
