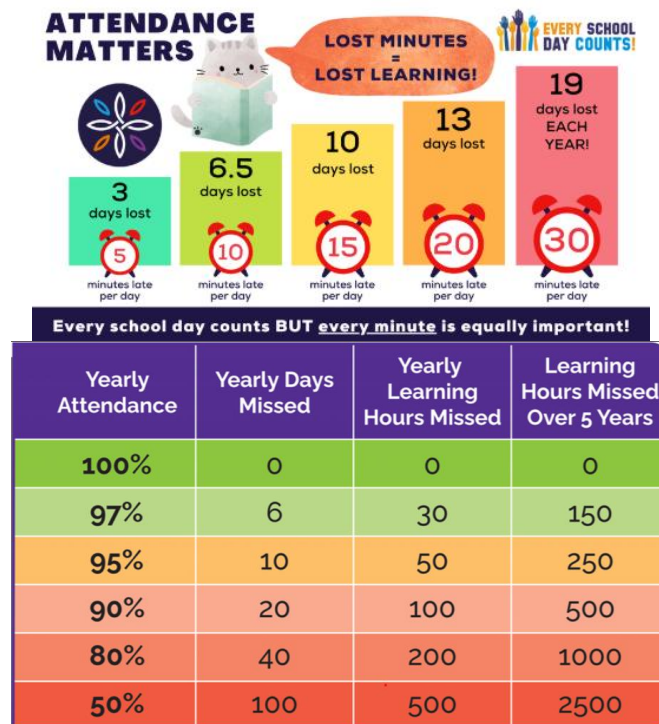
Week 20,
