It is not a parenting course, or a course about getting support for your child. It is about you! Parent carers are very busy. But can you give yourself or make some time for you?

The course is open to any parent-carer of a child or young person aged up to 25, with SEND, living in the London Borough of Enfield (unless you have already previously completed the course with us). The course lasts for 6 weeks and you will need to confirm you can and will attend all 6 weeks of the programme. Please see the attached flyer.
