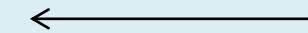

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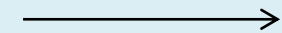

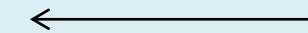

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You will need;

- Counters in two colours
- 0-9 number cards

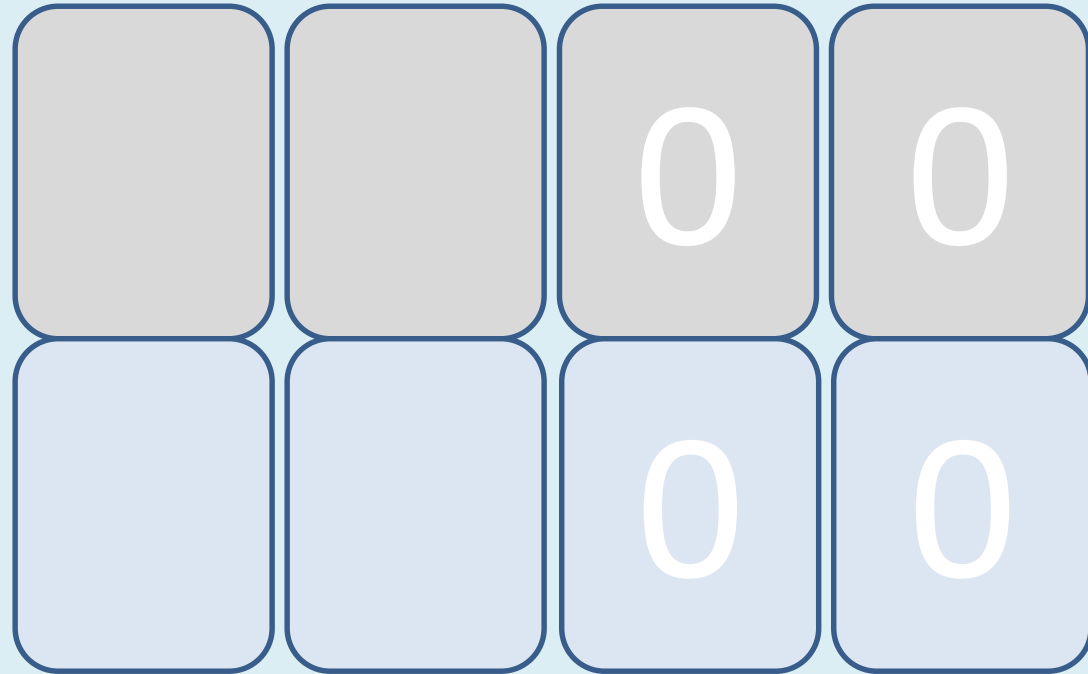
Before you start:

- Decide who has the blue or grey boxes
- what colour counters you are going to be
- Shuffle the number cards
- Place them face down in a pile

How to play

- Take turns to pick 2 cards
- Arrange them in the empty boxes
- Read the number you have made
- Put a counter of your colour on the circle that describes your number
- Put the cards back on the pile and shuffle
- The winner is the first person to complete a line of counters.
- The line can be a row, column or diagonal
