- Mrs Parsons tried the Achievement Assembly this week in front of one of the classes (who had to keep the nominated children a secret until everyone got to watch). She said that although it was still a very odd experience at least she was able to interact with some of the children.
- The majority of our Reception children are now fulltime and today they had their first PE lesson, much easier as they are coming in wearing their PE kits.

On Thursday we are all having our individual photographs taken (no sibling groups). Once one of the year groups is finished all of the surfaces will be disinfected before the next one comes in. If your children are in Year 1, Year 3 or Year 6 we want them wearing their normal uniform on this day. Their PE lessons will be class based on good diet choices or another healthy life style based activity.

Ocean Maths sessions were also due to start this week but due to this week's guidance and the change in the weather we are unable to invite parents in to join us. We will however produce a PowerPoint or video recording that you will be able to access after your Ocean Maths session date. This will also be the case for Reading Café sessions.

We are also due to celebrate Harvest in the week beginning 5th October, normally we have a large collection table in the hall for the week which we then box up and send to the Foodbank. We will be doing this but the collection table will be by the main gate - next week we will be confirming with the Foodbank the types of items they are currently in need of.

In light of recent Government guidance and the increase in the virus reproduction number I am asking parents to be mindful of the way they are waiting outside the gate before drop off and collection times. The road is still open, although there is less traffic so please don't stand in the road. Also we will be marking up the pavement to aid with social distancing. If you feel more comfortable wearing a mask when you drop off or collect your child I would encourage you to do this.
