Thank you to all the families who have been carrying out Later Flow Device (LFD) tests on their children so that we can identify anyone who is asymptomatic and reduce the spread of Covid 19. Attached to this email is the information flyer which tells you how to get hold of your testing kits. Please make sure that you register all of the test kit results with the NHS through their website or by using this QR code



If you have a positive result with the LDF tests you must complete a PCR test to confirm the result, until we have the confirmation from the PCR test we have to keep the whole bubble self-isolating, so the faster that you can book a test and let us know the results the better. You can book a test by calling 119, going onto the NHS website or using

If you get a test result over the weekend please email the [emergencies@chaseside.enfield.sch.uk](mailto:emergencies@chaseside.enfield.sch.uk) as this email account is checked over the weekend.

At the moment we have the Year 5 Bubble self-isolating as we are waiting for one of these PCR confirmation results, if I receive the results over the weekend I will be emailing and texting all the families involved over the weekend, so that I can confirm whether we need to continue the self-isolation or whether we have a false positive and can return to school.

We have had lots of questions related to the Easter break, we don't finish school until Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April and on that day due to the staggered pick up we will be finishing at the normal time. Nursery will be finishing on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> March so that we can deep clean the Nursery before the children return. Also we have an Inset day on the first day back, so the children won't be returning until Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> April.

Other dates for your diary we will be having Daffodil Breakfast for Year 1 and Year 2 separately on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> April, unfortunately due to the current conditions we will not be able to invite parents to help us.

This week the children in each class have nominated and voted on new school councillors. They are representing all of the children in their class and as such need to demonstrate the highest standards of behaviour as this is a great honour, if at any time they don't demonstrated the behaviours we are expecting they will be replaced by another member of their class.
