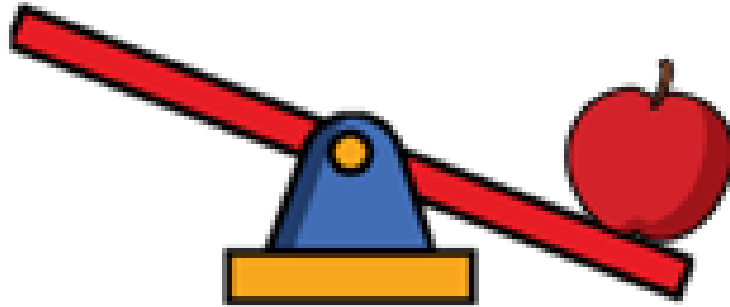
What vocabulary do we use when we measure mass?

How can we measure mass?



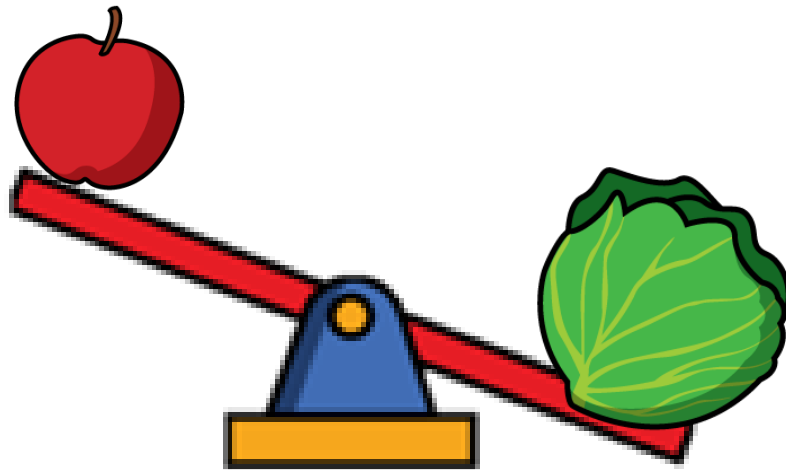
We can use a balance scale.



How can we describe the apple on the scales?

What objects is heavier?

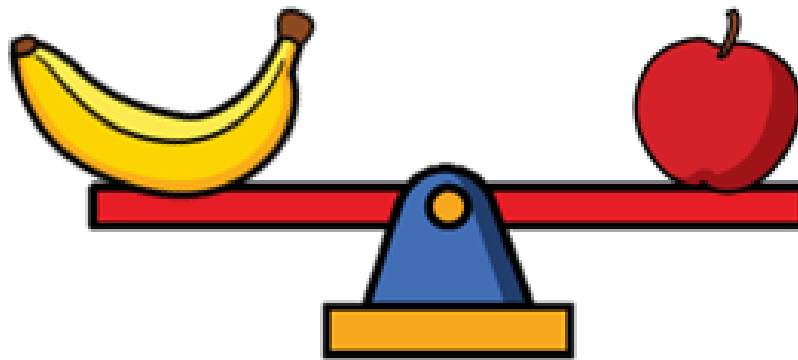


What object is lighter?

Let's compare mass.

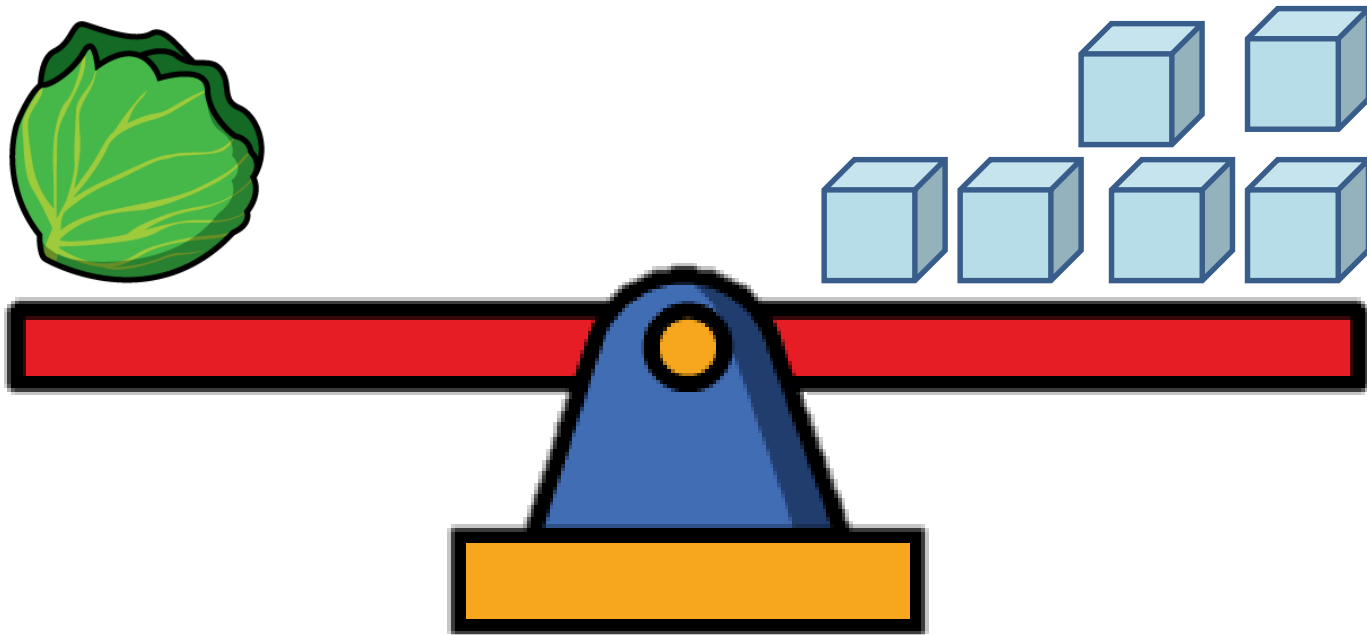


The scale is
balanced!

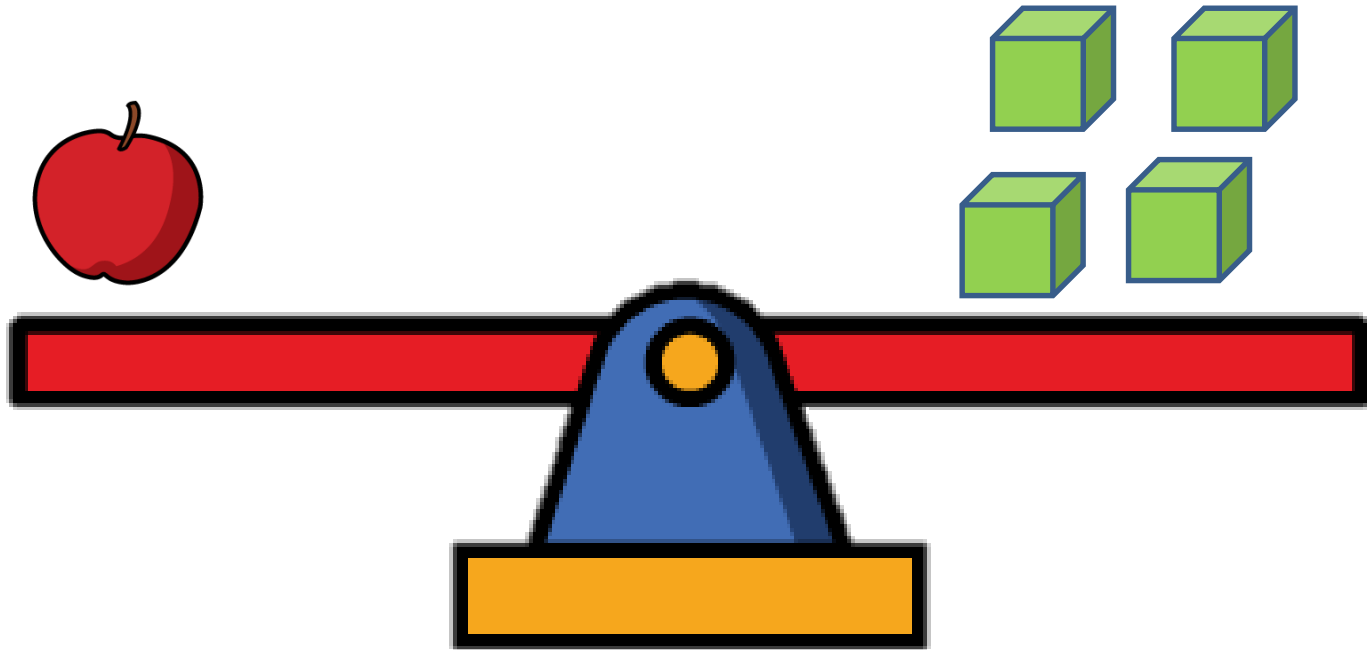


The  has **the same** mass as the 

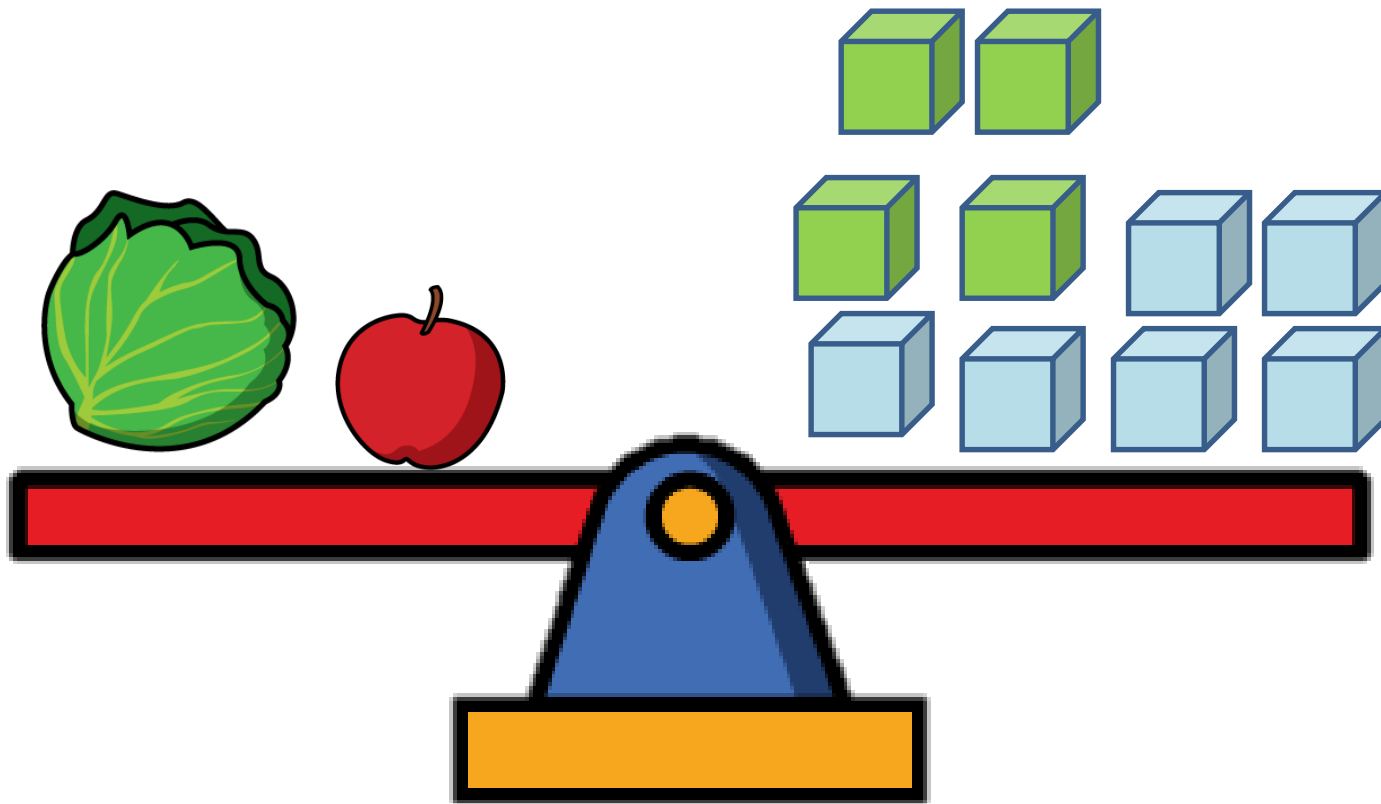
How many cubes balance the cabbage?
